

The Sidewalk Replacement Program is available to aid homeowners in replacing their hazardous sidewalks.

This program is a shared cost between the City of Ludington and the Property Owner – each paying 50% of the total cost.

The City of Ludington maintains a list of homeowners interested in having their sidewalk replaced. Once their name has been reached, the City will measure the sidewalk to be replaced and the owner is contacted with the cost, at which time they have two options as follows:

- 1.) The homeowner can pay for their portion before construction takes place.
- 2.) The homeowner can pay for 50% of their cost before construction takes place, and the remaining balance is due the following June 1st with an additional 6% interest. If the homeowner chooses not to pay the second payment by June 1st, it will automatically be added to their summer taxes of that year.
